June 1972: First gay newspaper Gay News, Britain 's first gay newspaper was a fortnightly publication founded by four members of the Gay Liberation Front and members of the Campaign for Homosexual Equality. It reported on discrimination and political and social advances but also campaigned for law reform. It ceased publication on 15 April 1983.
