GENERAL AVIATION - That portion of civil aviation which encompasses all facets of aviation except air carriers holding a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Civil Aeronautics Board and large aircraft commercial operators. GEOGRAPHIC NORTH - The northern axis around which the Earth revolves; aka "Map North" and TRUE NORTH. Also see MAGNETIC NORTH.

Apron: A designated space at an airport at which an aircraft can park for fueling and loading. Automatic Direction Finder: A radio navigator that automatically indicates an aircraft ' s bearing to a radio station based on signals in the LF or MF bandwidth. Also called ADF.

aerostat: A lighter-than-air craft, such as a balloon or airship. Its lift is caused by buoyancy relative to the surrounding air. ailerons: On an aircraft, the ailerons are a control surface usually on the trailing edge of the wings.
