Make sure the McCulloch chain saw has fresh fuel, at least half a tank. Test the chain brake, in front of the saw's top handle, to be sure it is not engaged to lock the chain. Test the chain to see that it moves freely, is not binding in the bar and is properly adjusted for tension; a bar that is binding or is too loose or too tight will interfere with saw operation.

Put on eye protection. Place the chain saw on the ground. Hold the chain saw securely with your foot by placing it through the handle located behind the engine. This will ensure the chain saw does not move as you pull the starter rope. Pull sharply on the starter rope five times. Watch the chain to be certain if it is running or not.

Mixing oil with gasoline keeps the chain saw's engine from seizing, and when mixed properly, prevents internal parts from excessive wear. If you have an older model chain saw, such as the Super PM 610, Pro Mac 605/610 or Eager Beaver 3.7 manufactured in the 1980s, McCulloch recommends using McCulloch Two-Cycle Custom Lubricant mixed with gasoline at a ratio of 40:1.
