In today's healthcare setting a professional portfolio is often a standard requirement. Completing the portfolio is a collaborative process between the trainee and the laboratory training officer, whose responsibility it is to ensure that the delivery of training, assessment of competence, and verification of knowledge and skill against each individual standard is signed off.

IBMS Registration Portfolio Workshop | University of ...

Band 6 candidates must be HCPC registered and have completed an IBMS specialist portfolio in Blood Sciences, Haematology or Clinical Chemistry (or equivalent). Candidates who are HCPC registered but do not yet possess their Specialist Portfolio would be placed on Band 6, Annex 21. Candidates graduating with HCPC this year are encouraged to apply.
