Superficial dry needling: The most common technique used is the initial method developed by Dr. Baldry. The needle is inserted into the skin above a trigger point just 5 millimeters (mm) to 10 mm deep for 30 seconds. The practitioner then feels the trigger point to determine if stimulation with the needle was sufficient to release the knot.

What is Dry Needling A thin filament needle is inserted into the soft tissue [trigger points] to stimulate healing. Dry needling can reduce pain, improve muscle function and decrease muscle tension. This is achieved by inserting the sterile needle into the myofascial trigger points (knot) which stimulates a sensory response.
